Comment:	The picture was probably taken in the context of an article reporting on the slaughterhouse in Sötlüce on the Golden Horn Haliç, maybe on the occasion of the preparations for Kurban bayramı. Preparations for this religious holiday and the start of festivities were reported in short articles and pictures that sometimes reappeared a year or two later on the same or similar occasions.
