Ivan Pophristov Karschovski (1839 - 1914) was a Bulgarian revolutionary, journalist, lawyer, and deputy at the Constituent and the First Bulgarian Assembly (1879). He was among the founders of the Bulgarian Literary Society (renamed "Bulgarian Academy of Sciences" in 1911). Another print of this photograph, mounted on cardboard, titled "Freedom or Death" and bearing the printed names of the people in the picture, is kept at "St. Cyril and St.

Methodius National Library" C 627.
