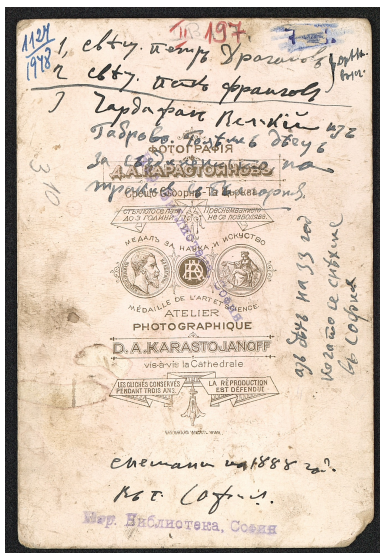

Object:	The priests Petar Draganov and Petko Frangov, and Prodan Tishkov
Description:	Studio portrait of two men wearing Orthodox priests' vestments with medals, and of a man carrying a sword and wearing a military uniform with insignias of honour and a hat with a cockade. They are sitting around a small table on which a book and some sheets of paper have been placed.
Comment:	Priests Petar Draganov (1843 - 1913), Petko Frangov, and Prodan Tishkov, known as Chardafon Velikiy (1860 - 1906). Tishkov was a Bulgarian volunteer in the Russo-Ottoman War of 1877 - 1878, sergeant major in the East Rumelia militia in Golyamo Konare (now Saedinenie). He actively took part in the preparation and proclamation of the Unification of Bulgaria in 1885. After the unification he became a major in the cavalry.
