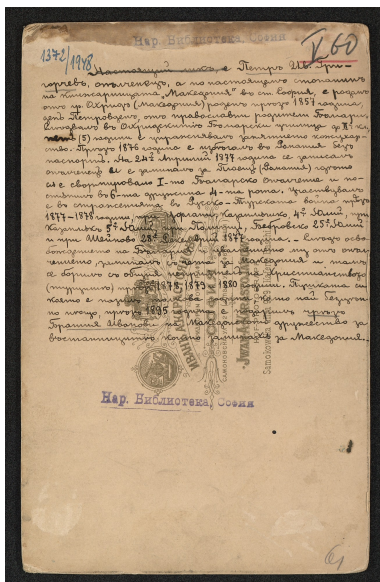

Description:	Full length shot of a man in military uniform with a fur cap and medals, holding a rifle with a bayonet. A painted canvas backdrop is creating the illusion of the scene being set in a park. Verso: handwritten inscription in Bulgarian probably by the Archive with biographical data about Petar Grigorchev.
Comment:	Petar Ivanov Grigorchev (1857 - 1920) from Ohrid was a opalchenets-pobornik meaning "volunteer combatant" in the Russo-Ottoman War of 1877–1878, participant in the Anti-Ottoman Uprising in Kresna (1878), and owner of a bookshop named "Macedonia" in Sofia.
