Prince Kiril, General Nikola Mihov and Professor Bogdan Filov, the former Prime Minister and Regent, as well as a number of former cabinet ministers and royal advisors were sentenced to death by a "People's Tribunal" / "Naroden sad" and executed

on 1 February 1945.
