Original text	τὸ γὰρ ἔθνος μέγα μὲν εἶναι τὸ τῶν Αἰτωλῶν καὶ μάχιμον, οἰκουν δὲ κατὰ κώμας ἀτειχίστους, καὶ ταύτας διὰ πολλοῦ, καὶ σκευῇ ψιλῇ χρώμενον οὐ χαλεπὸν ἀπέφαινον, πρὸν ἔυμβοηθῆσαι, καταστραφῆναι. ἐπιχειρεῖν δ' ἔκελευνον πρῶτον μὲν Αποδωτοῖς, ἔπειτα δὲ Ὄφιονεῦσι καὶ μετὰ τούτους Εὔρυτᾶσιν, ὅπερ μέγιστον μέρος ἔστι τῶν Αἰτωλῶν, ἀγνωστότατοι δὲ γλῶσσαν καὶ ὡμοφάγοι εἰσίν, ὡς λέγονται·
