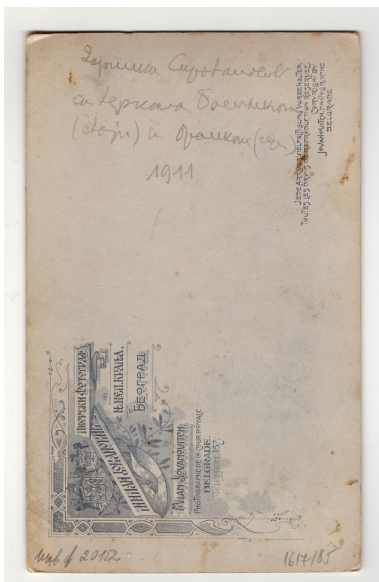

She is wearing her hair in crown braid. The two young women are wearing matching clothes: ornamented blouses and wrap-around skirts of the same fabric. One of them is sitting on a low stool, resting her right elbow on the armrest of the bench. The other young woman is standing in the back.
