Comment:	Archbishop of Belgrade and Serbian Metropolitan Mihailo (secular name: Miloje Jovanović 1826, Soko Banja–1898, Belgrade) was the head of the Serbian Orthodox Church during the rules of Miloš, Mihailo, Milan and Aleksandar Obrenović.
