Description:	Full-length shot of a man in stage costume. He is portraying Freudenreich's character Grga, the innkeeper. He is looking into a mirror with his right index finger raised. Behind him there is a padded armchair.
Comment:	'Grga' is a character in the theater play 'Graničari' (Boarder-guards) by Josip Freudenreich. Petar "Pera" Dobrinović (Belgrade, 1853 – Novi Sad, 1923) was an actor and director at the Serbian National Theatre in Novi Sad and at the Royal Serbian National Theatre in Belgrade. Before becoming one of the greatest actors on the Serbian stage, he worked as a journeyman in his father's barbershop in the centre of Belgrade.
