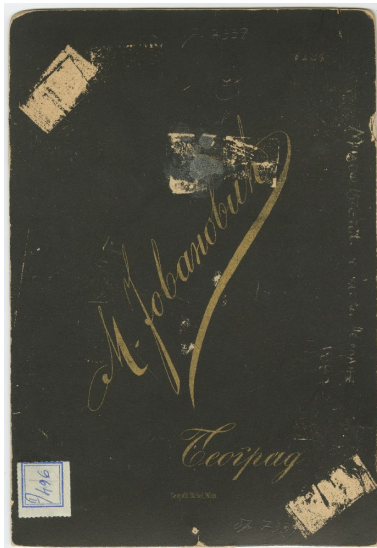

Object:	Studio portrait of Miloš Cvetić in character as 'Stefan Nemanja'
Description:	Full-length shot of a man dressed in a knight's armor, holding a shield and a sword. A painted canvas backdrop is creating the impression of the scene being set in a palace.
Comment:	Stefan Nemanja (~ 1113–1199) was the Grand Prince (Veliki Župan) of the Grand Principality of Serbia (Rascia) from 1166 until 1196 and heir to the Vukanović dynasty that marked the beginning of a greater Serbian realm (he is the founding father of the Nemanjić dynasty). Miloš Cvetić (1845, Čurug – 1905, Belgrade) was an actor, composer and writer.
