Description:	Full-length shot of a man wearing a dark robe and a white blouse with a lace collar. He has been photographed against a painted canvas backdrop depicting an old graveyard. He is looking up at the sky, holding his right hand against his chest.
Comment:	Vitomir A. - Cile Bogić (1887, Belgrade – 1943) was an actor at, as well as director and manager of, the Serbian National Theatre in Novi Sad and the Royal Theatre in Cetinje. He also became a famous radio performer and was one of the actors involved in the first Serbian silent film, "Life and Deeds of Immortal Vožd Karađorđe", in 1911. He was active in the resistance movements of 1941–1943 as well as in the Balkan wars and in WWI (1912–1918). He died in captivity in 1943.
