

Object:	Studio portrait of the boy Stefan (Asen) Stambolov
Description:	Full length shot of a boy in urban clothes leaned on a chair, standing in front of a painted canvas backdrop.
Comment:	Stefan (Asen) Stambolov (1894 - 1972) was the son of Stefan Stambolov (1854 - 1895), who was a Bulgarian politician, a deputy at the Bulgarian Founding Assembly of 1879, Vice Chairman and later Chairman of the Bulgarian Parliament; Regent from 1886 until the proclamation of Ferdinand of Saxe-Coburg-Gotha as Knyaz of the autonomous Principality of Bulgaria in 1887, and Prime Minister for seven years (1887 - 1894).
