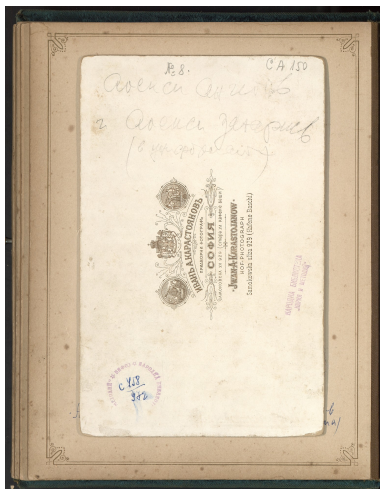

Object:	Studio portrait of Aleksi Popangelov and Aleksi Zahariev
Description:	Full length shot of two men, standing next to a small covered round table with a photograph on it: a younger man in military uniform with a hat with a cockade and a middle-aged man in urban clothes with an overcoat and a fur cap.
Comment:	In plain city clothes: Aleksi Popangelov (Angelov) (1850 - 1935), who was a teacher and writer and an active member of the Bulgarian Revolutionary Movement; volunteer in the Serbo-Ottoman War (1876) and in the Russo-Ottoman War (1877 - 1878); Deputy. The photograph is kept in his family album.
